# OPPOSING CULTURES OR STANCES

Caribbean churches are often open to the culture of individualism and intellectual knowledge.

Cultural mismatch can lead to misunderstandings and ineffective discipleship strategies.

# AN INDEPENDENT AND SELF-SUFFICIENT CULTURE

It becomes difficult for members to accept leadership or mentorship...seeing weakness vs. strength.

This culture hinders the relational aspect of discipleship which requires openness to guidance and support from others.

## Cultural Resistance to Change

-a strong preference for maintaining local traditions and doing the same things for years.

It limits the church's ability to adapt discipleship models, ineffective outreach with little or no discipleship efforts.

# A CULTURE THAT LACKS PRACTICAL APPLICATION AND FOLLOW-UP

Without practical application and ongoing support, discipleship efforts will not bring about spiritual change, nor integration of members into the church community, but will result in a high attrition rate and limited church growth.

**Human Resources**: Members serve as vital human resources by actively participating in gospel preservation, discipleship within the church, evangelism to outsiders, leadership training, and support of church leadership.



**Financial:** The financial contributions of church members are a vital resource that enables the church to fulfill its mission and serve its community effectively.



**Church's mission**: Through active participation and engagement in various ministries, church members contribute to the fulfillment of the church's mission of spreading the gospel, serving the community, and making a positive impact on society.



**School enrollment**: Membership and church school enrollment are interconnected. they shared values, beliefs, and a commitment to our teachings, fostering a sense of belonging, support, and shared spiritual journey that is unique to members and school families.

There is a discrepancy between the total number of registered members and the number of active participants.

There are barriers that prevent members from feeling welcomed, valued, and appreciated for participating in the mission and activities of the church.




#### Membership Audit Concern

There is insufficient efforts in disciplining our members.

Church programming and outreach strategies do not effectively meet the needs and interests of the local community.

There is a high middle-aged Adventist population compared to the trend of younger demographics in other areas within the Caribbean Union



#### Membership Audit Concern

A lack of young adults can lead to an imbalance that limits the vitality, diversity and long-term viability of local church communities.

The number of young people leaving the church has risen steadily in recent years.







Regular attendance often goes hand in hand with consistent financial support.


Regular attendees are likelier to invite friends and family to church events, contributing to church growth and revitalization.
